

EQUATE Internship Terms & Conditions

Submission Timeline

Internship applications must be submitted at least two months prior to the intended start date.

General Requirements

- o Internship opportunities at EQUATE are available only to students who are required to complete industrial training as part of their academic curriculum or graduation requirements.
- A formal letter from the academic institution confirming this requirement must be provided.
- Students must complete the internship application and submit all required documents as listed below.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must be in their final year of study or enrolled in a course that requires internship training as part of the curriculum.
- Minimum GPA Requirements:
- University students: 2.8 / 4.0
- > PAAET students: 2.5 / 4.0
- A complete academic transcript showing all completed courses and current GPA must be submitted.
- o Only students enrolled in engineering programs within scientific disciplines are eligible.
- o Applicants are subject to security screening by relevant authorities.
- If the applicant has a security record, the entry permit will be denied, and the application will be rejected automatically.

Internship Norms

- All interns must follow EQUATE's Environment, Health & Safety (EH&S) rules throughout the internship.
- o Interns must always be accompanied by an EQUATE employee while inside the plant.
- o Interns must maintain punctuality as per their assigned training schedule.
- o Any absence must be immediately reported to the assigned EQUATE focal point.
- o Smoking is strictly prohibited within EQUATE premises, except in designated areas.
- o Driving within EQUATE plants is not allowed without written approval from EH&S.
- o Interns must adhere to appropriate dress code:
- o Short sleeves, sleeveless shirts, skirts, shorts, and national dress (dishdasha) are not allowed.
- o Interns are not permitted to perform plant-related tasks or work.
- o Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) must be worn where applicable.
- o Interns who violate rules related to punctuality, behavior, safety, or attendance may be dismissed from the program.
- o Laptops, cameras, and mobile phones are prohibited inside EQUATE premises.
- o Interns must sign a Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement before the internship begins.
- Sharing EQUATE's internal data or information is strictly prohibited.
